• Students will become familiar with circular agriculture applications in different ecological contexts and learn about research-stakeholder interactions for project success.

- Students will learn about the history and diverse cultures of Panama.
- Trip includes visits to local universities, experimental and demostration units, indigenous villages, Panama Canal and protected areas.

FEWSUS grant covers in-country expenses. Specifically, lodging in shared accomodation, project activities, transportation, meals (incl. lunches, welcome and farewell dinner), ground shared transfer from Knoxville to/from Atlanta.

Students are expected to cover airfare (~\$600 ATL-PTY) and other expenses <u>not covered</u> by grant (e.g. partial meals, personal items and incidentals).
